Research shows that as many as four million people are now working from home, many of whom use computers in their work. It is no longer sufficient to use the kitchen table and the odd corner of a cupboard to control their work, so we present a range of options for the modern home office, ranging from the use of a spare bit of room under a stairway to the full-blown dedicated study for use in business or for homework.

Our first is the **Rosemary**, seen here fitted under an open stairway. The model shown here is in Limed Oak, but finishes are also available in Almond Maple and Coriander Pearwood. Making the best possible use of restricted space, the **Rosemary** office provides a surprising amount of storage and desk space whilst making a positive contribution to the decoration of the room.



Using just a bit more space, but perfectly suitable for installation in a bedroom, we have the **Woodford** shown below in maple, although also available in limed oak. This simple yet eye catching design is thoroughly modern but again makes an excellent enhancement to any dual purpose room.



The versatile design of **Thyme** retains the ageless warmth of wood while complementing modern creativity. Overall, the effect of this design is to replicate the feel of the study of days of yesteryear.



Shown here purely as a study in antiqued oak, the style is sufficiently flexible to accommodate the modern needs of a high-tech office with adequate space for computer, printer, and other modern day office necessities

When we first saw the **Pimenta** range (shown below), we were struck by its classical simplicity, its unalloyed luxury and the warmth of its finish. We imagined ourselves sitting in one of the armchairs with a balloon of fine brandy until we were brought back to reality!
